

RULES

Our Obligations

We intend to give your children a very high quality of education. Alhamdulillah we do not hit the children at all. We teach them about various aspects of Islaam and we adopt a gentle method and we are very strict about teaching them the correct Islaam. We will teach them about worshipping Allah and following the Sunnah of Muhammad sallallahu alaihi wa sallam. We will teach them good manners insha'Allah and how to become good, honest muslims insha'Allah.

Your Obligations

We expect every parent to take a serious interest in educating their children. This is extremely important, because if a student is not doing well in the school or is behaving badly than 90% of the time it is because the parents do not educate them or spend time with them. These children are our future so we should make time to sit with them and teach them. I know that some of the sisters are single mothers, and it must be very difficult for you but even you must make time to sit with your children and spend time with them. And the reward of all your efforts is with Allah.

Prayer

The Prayer is extremely important. It is important because the Prophet said that the difference between the Muslims and the non-Muslims is the prayer. And some of the scholars say that the one who does not pray is not even a Muslim!

In this centre your children will learn how to pray insha'Allah. But we expect you to order them to pray 5 times a day from the age of 7. Tell your children to pray and pray with them and Allah will bless you insha'Allah. For the men, you should try your best to bring your boys to the Masjid for the prayers.

Behaviour

We do not tolerate bad behaviour. Any students caught swearing or fighting will be suspended immediately and if the behaviour does not improve they will be taken out of the school. Again this is where we need the support of the parents. We need you to teach your children good manners at home and we will teach them good manners in the classes insha'Allah.

Time-Keeping

We are very strict with making sure that all students arrive to the classes on time. Once the class starts, the door is closed and no more students are allowed to enter. If you are running late, you must call and tell us why. If you do not call, your child will not be allowed to enter the class.

Books

We will give each student a Qa'idah at a cost of £4 each. It is very important that they bring this book with them, if they do not have their book they will have to buy a new book otherwise they cannot attend the classes. They also need to have a pen and a writing book with them.

Dress code

Since this is an Islamic school, we expect all the students to be dressed in suitable clothing. This means that they must either wear a thawb or a long shirt to cover them. Pictures of faces are NOT ALLOWED.

Hygiene

From good manners it is to be clean and remove any bad smells that you may have with you. If you have just eaten, then clean out your mouth before you come to the school. Remember that this is a Masjid and you must not bring any bad smells even near the Masjid.

Payment

It is important to remember that we are a charity organisation and we run on school fees and donations. The payment for the school must be made 1 month in advance. The fees are £30 per student per month.
